**SPORTS EVENTS THIS WEEK** Three teams of children from Year 4, 5 and 6 competed in a Tri-Golf competition today. The children all enjoyed themselves and Year 4 and 5 finished in second place.

**DUNCHURCH FETE – Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> June.** The Junior School will be taking part in this year's procession with a walking float of 101 Dalmations. Those that wish to join our procession are encouraged to dress as a character from this classic Disney film by wearing something white with black spots, such as a white bin liner or T-shirt with black spots drawn on or attached. If parents wish to dress up too it may save them the entry fee to the fete! Whilst we would love as many children to take part as possible, they do still remain the responsibility of the parents who may walk along with us at the sides. Please ensure that you arrive on the playground for 12 o'clock to be in time to leave with the procession at 12.30pm (this includes children who are in the choir and wish to walk with the procession). If your child is performing with the choir and does not wish to take part in the procession, please bring them to meet Mrs Blezard in front of the village hall at 1pm.

**LEAMINGTON FESTIVAL** Mrs Allison and Mrs Blezard would like all brass band and choir members who are taking part in the forthcoming Leamington festival to practise their brass and singing parts as much as possible between now and the competition. On the day, brass and choir members who are performing at the festival, and parent helpers, should arrive in school at 8.30am.
