**TEACHER TRAINING DAY** A reminder that Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June is a Teacher Training Day and therefore the school is closed to children on that day.

**DUNCHURCH FETE** – Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> June. The Junior School will be taking part in this year's procession with a walking float of 101 Dalmations. Those that wish to join our procession are encouraged to dress as a character from this classic Disney film by wearing something white with black spots, such as a white bin liner or T-shirt with black spots drawn on or attached. If parents wish to dress up too it may save them the entry fee to the fete!
