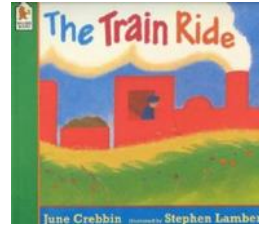

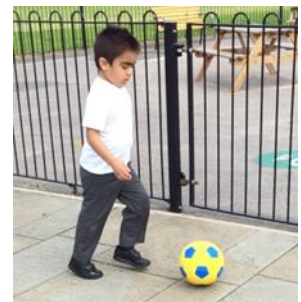

This week have had lots of fun doing work based on the story "The Very Hungry Caterpillar". We especially loved making butterfly sandwiches in cooking.



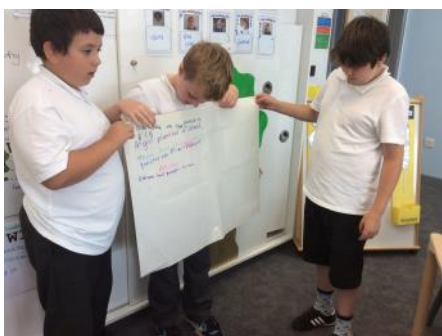
