Building work will commence on Monday for the EYFS outdoor area and last all week. The children will be unable to play in this area during this time however once complete it will provide our children with an exciting and educational outdoor provision. I have to thank the National Grid for their grant to make this area possible. As part of the building work you will have noticed our shed has moved – it will be used as part of an outdoor reading and writing area as we continue to look at ways of developing our grounds to ensure our children have the best possible experience. If you have any suggestions about the outdoor (or indoor) areas please let staff know as we value your input.

The Blue Room is in the middle of a change as well as we ensure our children are able to access it as they grow – it had become cramped and difficult to use with small groups. New furniture and resources have been ordered to ensure it continues as our Friends of Broughton Moor originally wished it to be used. The changes to the doors for Reception and Year 1 have had to come about due to safety.

You will find a copy of your child's report with our newsletter. Most important for us is the personal and social comments; this section lets you know what your child is like in school and how impressed we are with them. It has comments about all subject areas as well as an attainment and progress tick box. Please do not worry about the wording of the columns, this is the language used by the Department for Education. As a parent myself I would always look at the progress box. If you have any questions about your child's report please talk to either your child's class teacher or me. We look forward to you completing the feedback sheet so we can look at ways of improving our school further next year.

The library van will be in school next week so if you could have a look for any library books which have come from school it would be greatly appreciated. If you have any Broughton Moor books could you also return those please?

In September we should have the same structure to the school. In the morning we will have a Reception/Year 1 class, a Year 2/3 class and a Year 4/5/6 class. In the afternoon we will have a Reception/Year 1/2 class and a Y3/4/5/6 class. Teachers will remain in their current positions and Teaching Assistants should remain roughly where they are at the moment. If you have any questions about the structure of the school please ask.
