Before children leave in Year 6 on their journey to high school the children need to undertake sessions is SRE.

Sex and relationship education (SRE) is compulsory from age 11. It involves teaching children about healthy relationships, reproduction and sexual health. It does not promote early sexual activity or any particular sexual orientation.

Some parts of sex and relationship education are compulsory – these are parts of the national curriculum for science. Parents have the right to withdraw their children from the SRE sessions.
