



Your child can start to qualify for Pupil Premium if you get any of the following:

- Child Tax Credit, (but **not** Working Tax Credit) and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed **£16,190**
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (for this, you will need to apply directly to the school, **not** to Bradford Council).

If a parent is entitled to Working Tax Credit 'run-on' (the payment someone can get for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit) their children can apply to qualify for the Pupil Premium.

Pupil Premium

The [pupil premium](#) is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of certain pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

- Breakfast Club (Place depending on numbers)
- School Trips (Voluntary Contribution)
