Reminder: Year 6 Endangered Species Day


On Thursday 15th September Yr 6 children will be going to Upper Wharfedale School with their peers in the cluster.

The Task : Students have to produce a marketing pitch to encourage and persuade the rest of their year group to vote to SAVE their animal from extinction. Students will be split into groups of 4/5. In those groups students must organise themselves into who will do what and assign themselves with one of the allocated roles given to them. They are given a list of materials they can use in their presentation (laptop, pens, paper etc) but each item will be given a unit price. Students will then be given a sum of money they can use to 'buy' their materials. They must think carefully how they manage their money.

Aims of the Day:

- To learn about why certain animals are endangered.
- To learn about different habitats around the world.
- To develop personal learning and thinking skills, with a focus on team work, enterprise, research and presentation skills.
- Students to experience managing a financial budget.

All children need to take a packed lunch. The day starts at UWS at 9am and finishes there at 3.15pm. If you have not already done so please fill in the attached consent slip. Final details regarding transport to follow.



Cross Country - Reception to Yr 6

Dinner and Sports Charges

Dinners: Yr 3, 4, & 5: £2.10 per day x 34 days = £71.40

Yr 6: £2.10 per day x 33 days (exc 15th Sept) = £69.30

Nursery children £1.60 per day + £1.50 care costs = £3.10 per day

Swimming: Yr 1, 2, 3, 4, & 5 £4 per week x 7 weeks = £28.00

Yr 6: £4 per week x 6 weeks (exc 15th Sept) = £24.00


Sport: Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 £1 per week x 7 weeks = £7.00 This is charge towards transport costs payable in advance. **An adjustment will be made to the following half terms fee when any reduction due because PE is held at school rather than the Village Hall will be taken in to account.**

Adjustments: If you have any credits or debits for dinners from last term then please add or deduct from the dinner amount payable. Likewise if you have any debits or credits from swimming/sport then please deduct from the swimming/sport amount.
