Our School Colours

Bush Hill Park Primary School colours are dark green, grey and white.

Our school uniform comprises

Plain white shirt, white polo shirt (with school logo)

Grey skirt or pinafore or trousers

Dark green jogging bottoms (Nursery and Reception only)

Dark green round necked sweatshirt (with school logo)

Or

Dark green or grey cardigan or V-necked jumper (with school logo)

Or

Dark Green Zip fronted fleece with school logo

Grey or white socks or tights

Girls may wear headscarves/hijab for religious purpose but these must be plain black, grey, green or white.

Sturdy flat shoes with grip that allow children to run safely should be plain and preferably black.

Uniform for P.E.

Plimsolls or trainers in a shoe bag for P.E. lessons

Dark green shorts and white T-shirt for P.E.

Dark green jogging bottoms (especially Early Years)

Dark green jogging bottoms for outdoor P.E. in cold weather

Jewellery in School

Please ensure that your child does not wear jewellery to school with the exception of studs or sleepers for children with pierced ears. Parents of children who wear an item of jewellery for religious reasons should see the Headteacher. Parents must ensure that children do not wear sleepers on P.E. days or can take them out easily at school.

Equipment

Summer term

Green and white check/ stripe dresses in summer

In the summer term we like children to bring a hat or cap to protect them from the sun on hot days. These should be the yellow school cap, available from the school office.

Other

Nail varnish, body or hair colour paints are not to be worn to school. The exception to this rule is on notified non-school uniform days.

Jeans, football kit and sports tracksuits are not permitted

Other

Tattoos (with the exception of henna designs during religious/cultural festivals), transfers, nail varnish, body or hair colour paints are not to be worn to school. The exception to this rule is on notified non-school uniform days.

Jeans, football kit and sports tracksuits are not permitted

All clothes must be plain and not embellished with non-school logos, ornamentation or slogans.

Where to get the uniform

All items of school uniform are available in the Uniform Shop which is held every Friday after school in the mini-hall in the main building. **IT IS MOST IMPORTANT THAT ALL ITEMS ARE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE CHILD'S NAME.**

It is not essential that you buy the official uniform we offer, but we **expect all families to ensure that school colours are worn**
