Ways you can help your child at home:

- Bring in photographs of family events, medals and certificates of achievement from extra-curricular clubs for your child to discuss with the teacher and the class.
- Discuss how to play fairly and resolve conflicts without physical intervention.
- Teach your child to dress and undress independently.
- Teach your child to recognise their first name so they can identify their belongings
This does not mean they need to be able to read it, but merely recognise the shape and length of their name.
- Learn how to turn their coat sleeves the right way round.
- 4 or more reads per week (when reading books have been issued).
- Practise their sound books daily.
