<p>Managing self - Self registration, hanging up coat, feeding, washing hands, putting on apron, putting on and taking off coat. Routines - hello song, lunchtime song, good bye song</p> <p>Choosing activities, putting resources away Getting to know other children and making friends - playing circle games, sharing and taking turns.</p> <p>Develop self care activities through daily routines.</p> <p>Day/night routines for dolls/teddy e.g. dress dolls ready for bed/day, feed, brush hair, brush teeth</p> <p>Assembly, Harvest Festival, Christmas Concert</p>	<p>Develop signing through daily activities e.g. hello, goodbye, snack time, and through rhymes/songs. Vocabulary about dark and light, day and night, nocturnal animals, bedtime, morning routines Jolly phonics songs and actions. Exploring sounds - action sounds e.g. wheee, boing, animal sounds, water sounds Noisy nursery rhymes Baby Moves Language and communication sessions, encourage/introduce language/signing, see and learn activities.</p>	<p>Action songs and rhymes e.g. head, shoulders, knees and toes, Actions/signing to stories, rhymes and songs Body awareness activities, Activate, Parachute games Using large vehicles, trolleys or bags to transfer items Self Care - Develop self care activities through daily routines. e.g. washing hands, putting on apron, putting on and taking off coat etc, dressing frames Baby Moves Transferring items Moving like nocturnal animals – tiptoe/creep like a mouse, fly like an owl Moving in different ways – travelling e.g. rolling, crawling, running Stepping stones, climbing equipment Manipulating objects to make sounds - noisy toys, music mats, instruments Exploring different balls - throwing, rolling, squidgy ball game Show awareness of feet and hands when being massaged.</p>

<p>Possible books :</p> <p>I hear, Owl Babies, Winifred’s New Bed, Goodnight Maisy, Night Monkey Day Monkey, Twinkle twinkle little star , Christmas story, Ten in the Bed, Ten fat sausages, Polar Bear Boy, This is the bear and the scary night, Draw me a star, Wheels on the bus, Peace at Last One Child One Seed – pumpkin lantern for Halloween, pumpkin pie/cake Writing letters/mark making in the sand (wet and dry), cornflour, shaving foam etc. Squiggle whilst we wiggle Jolly phonics songs and actions, matching and identifying letters</p> <p>Listening &amp; responding to stories/rhymes See and Learn activities, themed picture and word matching boards</p>	<p>Counting songs and rhymes – 10 in the bed, 5 little monkeys etc Bedtime and morning routines – sequencing Tea set – lay table, matching and sorting Exploring shapes i/c circle, star, moon Counting, sorting and matching – toys, resources, familiar objects, pictures e.g. owls, stars Water and Sand play – transferring/pouring, big/little, long/short, finding and counting objects, small medium and large containers and objects, full, empty, big, little, half full, overflowing. Make sets of items e.g. 3 beds, label with numeral card. Counting songs &amp; rhymes: 10 in the bed, 10 fat sausages Using different sized containers in sand and water tray. Language of time – long/short, fast/slow, days of the week</p>	<p>Using musical/noisy toys Water play – cups, funnels, teapots, jugs, different coloured water, Sand play – figures, tea set, sieves, adding water to sand, bubbles Construction – houses Exploring senses – tasting different food; feeling textures and temperatures; dark and light: hand massage, sensory counting and stories: tracking lights/bubbles. Treasure baskets &amp; Heuristic play Explore materials – hard and soft ICT – rhymes, songs and stories on computer, Collect water on rainy day</p>	<p>Make day and night display – moon and sun collage, owl pictures Day and night mobile Star decorations Christmas pictures/artwork Firework pictures Making different sounds for stories and pictures e.g. Peace at Last, fireworks</p> <p>Sound effects for stories, Songs – actions songs, nursery rhymes, counting songs, Harvest, Winter and Christmas songs Role play – bedtime and daytime routines Play dough mats – night and day Build with boxes (outdoor play) Fireworks – sounds, move like fireworks</p>
