Dear Parent's/Carers,

As part of our topic 'Knights, Dragons and Castles', we would like the opportunity to take the children to Stansted Mountfitchet Castle on Thursday 13th October 2016. As part of the trip, the children are also able to visit the toy museum.

Mountfitchet Castle is a Norman Motte and Bailey Castle and Village, re-constructed on its original ancient site, complete with many different buildings, siege weapons and animals roaming freely throughout the 10 acre site, providing a unique insight into community life in Domesday England. The Toy Museum is the largest privately owned toy museum in the world, with at least 80,000 exhibits on display from late Victorian times up to the 1980's.

We will be travelling by coach straight after morning registration, so please arrive in school at the usual time. The children will require a packed lunch, please put this in a named plastic bag so it can be disposed of, can we ask that you do not provide sweets or fizzy drinks. If you require a 'school packed lunch' can you please let the office know in advance. The children will need to be in full school uniform, with comfortable shoes and a raincoat.

We will not be visiting the gift shop as there are 72 children and the shop is only small. The cost of the school visit will be £14 per child. This will be available to pay on Wisepay, or at the office. Please sign the consent form below along with payment by Friday 7th October 2016.
