



### Literacy

Much of our writing will be based around 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. We will be writing stories with suspense, character portraits and recipes. We will continue to work on weekly spelling patterns and our grammar work will focus on punctuating dialogue and using connectives.

### Numeracy

Learning will include:

- Place value – to know the place value of each digit in a two or three digit number or beyond
- Read write and order numbers up to 100 and beyond
- 3, 4 and 8 times tables
- Add and subtract single, two and three digit numbers
- Money, e.g., adding totals and subtracting to give change
- Measuring mass – weighing
- Multiplication and division facts.

### History

Learning about famous people in the food industry, e.g., James Lind, George Cadbury.

### Geography

We will be learning about food miles and Fair Trade.
