As Artists we will:

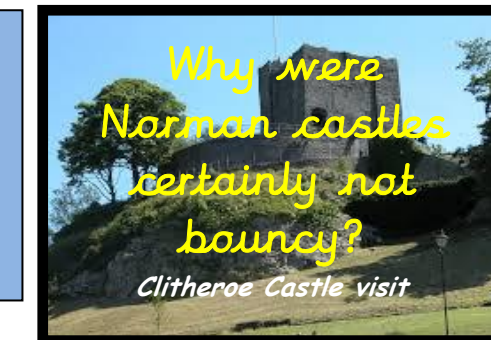
- Create a clay plaque of a Norman castle.
