Mental addition and subtraction

Addition and subtraction facts up to 20, 50 and 100

Using the = sign to represent equality

Recognise lines of symmetry, complete symmetrical drawings. Describe, name and sort 2D shapes. Describe, name and sort 2D shapes using a Venn diagram. Describe, name and sort 3D shapes. Describe, name and sort 3D shapes using a Carroll diagram.

Topic

Literacy

Instructions and explanations - Children will learn about instructions and explanations based around our science topic! They will learn about features of explanations before going on to write their own based on a healthy lunch with a special treat at the end!

Letters - Christmas is coming. This builds up to Christmas with writing letters to Father Christmas, learning about tense, writing in the 3rd person and using powerful verbs, reading Dear Father Christmas by Alan Durant.

Science**Animals including Humans**

Our question for this topic is 'Can Usain Bolt run as fast as a cheetah?'
During this term the children will be looking at:

Different food groups - Revising what humans and animals need to be healthy and grow.

Balanced diets - Discussing different diets & the need for a balanced diet. The effects of exercise.

Transport - Finding out how food is broken down into smaller bits in the mouth, stomach & intestine.

Skeletons - Discuss the main functions of skeletons: support, protection & movement. Find out that some animals have exoskeletons. Compare them with endoskeletons like humans have.
