**The improvements I would like to see are:**

- Teaching children to be more independent.
- More educational trips for both academic and PE would be fantastic to increase confidence, resilience etc.
- Parents evenings are always a pleasant experience. Suggest more focus on learning outcomes, targets achieved and samples of work completed rather than just photographs
- Better planning for external trips and visits – improved information sharing with parents and students.
- Maintain focus on student voice to ensure activities are completed.
- More day to day home school diary comments.
- More / easier access to after school activities.
- Prefer parents evening as opposed to review.
