### Reading

### Spellings

Spellings will be given out on Friday in the book bags, for children to practise ready for a test the following Friday. The sounds/words will follow their particular Read, Write Inc Set program.

### Homework

The children will receive a homework journal this term, and have a choices grid in their book. They choose a piece of homework they would like to try each week, unless a specific piece of maths homework has been given. The journals are returned each week in the children's homework bags.

### PE

Our PE lessons are on Wednesday afternoons. Please send your child's PE kit into school in a named bag. Please also name each piece of P.E kit to avoid lost items.

### French

Ms Ridley will be taking the children for French every Monday, and they may bring home a piece of homework occasionally.

### Music

Music will be on a Monday afternoon with Mrs. Boyd.
