Hornsea Burton Primary School is committed to the development of PE & Sport and uses this grant to further enhance its existing provision.

Our rationale for the use of the Sports Premium Funding is as follows:

- all children benefit regardless of sporting ability
- all children are given the opportunity to compete in cluster tournaments with other schools
- staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development
- we make use of collaborative and partnership working

The Sports Premium Funding has been beneficial in assisting with the development of our provision for PE and school sport. We continue to work towards all staff improving their knowledge and skills to enhance their delivery of PE/games lessons and continue to adapt the curriculum/sports clubs to meet the needs of the children.

Objective

- To effectively use the Sports Grant to raise the profile and outcomes for all children in PE, sport and physical activity across school.
- To upskill and raise confidence levels of all staff to deliver high quality PE and sports lessons.
- To increase participation of children in physical activity at lunchtime and with after school clubs.
- To increase participation in competitive sport

Spending Record 2015 - 2016

Objective

To improve the teaching of games and the learning experience for pupils.

Activity

To employ qualified coaches from Fit 4 Fun and The Tigers Education Trust who will model good practice to teachers and provide them also with CPD.

Cost

0.5 days per week all year re Fit 4 Fun £3315 **and 0.5 days per week for 6 months Tigers Trust £1500.**

To provide after school Clubs for pupils linked to Sport.

To employ qualified coaches from Fit 4 Fun and The Tigers Education Trust and Dave Boast Football Coach who will each run after school club one night a week.

1 hour a week all year re Fit 4 Fun **£731.25, Tigers Trust 1 hour per week for 6 months (included in price above).**
Dave Boast 1 hour a week for a term £910

To provide children with access to cluster competitive sports activities.
