Reading Activity Ideas

- Spell words using children, cards, magnetic letters, beanbags, letter tiles, puppets
- Give each child a phoneme. Call out specific letters and children stand up. What have they spelt?
- Sound walks
- Find letters in sand/water/cornflour /glitter/soil etc
- Phonic fishing games
- Make sound books
- Phoneme frames
- Phonic fans
- Sort objects into hoops according to their sound
- Missing sound puzzles
- ICT activities – e.g Jolly phonics CD, Choose it ready –mades, Wordshark, ICT Games
- Bingo/Snap/lotto games
- Guided/Independent reading
- Homework

Ideas**

- Quick write on whiteboards
- Make sound books
- Phoneme frames for 3/4/5 letters
- Write sentences/Captions
- Form letters in paint, sand, shaving foam, icing
- Formal worksheets – pre-writing patterns, circles, lines, zig zags, curves, letters, missing sounds
- Stencils/rubbings/tracings
- Smaller writing tools
- Writing outside
- Fine motor activities – tweezers/threading/play dough
- Ribbon sticks/scarves/movement/brain gym
- ICT activities – Clicker/First Keys/2 Create/laptops etc
- Use megasketchers/drawing toys/whiteboards
- Writing during play – make lists, cards, phone messages, appointments
- Formal Handwriting sessions
- Pre-writing skills – straight lines, circles, garlands/bridges, curves, zig-zags, figure of 8, spirals.
