

### **Link with Heath Mount Independent School:**

### **Leadership:**

## **Physical Education & Sports - Enrichment 2016/17**

### **Competitions:**

- The Hertford & Ware School Sports Partnership (HWSSP) run various sports competitions throughout the year.
- We try to enter as many as possible and give as many children in years 5/6 the opportunity to represent the school competitively.
- The Hertford & Ware Primary Sports Association (of which we are a member), also run weekly netball and football fixtures amongst the member schools.



### **Extra-Curricular Clubs:**

- 6 sports clubs offered to the children for the autumn term, this includes clubs for KS1 & KS2 pupils.
- Particular attention has been paid to feedback from parents regarding sports clubs for KS1 children, with netball and football clubs for the younger pupils.
- Different sports clubs will be offered for the spring and summer terms, with as many different sports and activities as possible.
