Democracy	<p>Respect for democracy & support for participation in the democratic process.</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Provide pupils with a broad general knowledge of, & promote respect for, public institutions ii. Teach pupils how they can influence decision-making through the democratic process iii. Include in the curriculum information on the advantages of democracy & how it works in Britain iv. Encourage pupils to become involved in decision-making processes & ensure they are listened to in school v. Hold school council elections vi. Help pupils to express their views vii. Model how perceived injustice can be peacefully challenged
The Rule of Law	<p>Respect for the basis on which the law is made & applies in England.</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Ensure school rules & expectations are clear & fair ii. Help pupils to distinguish right from wrong iii. Help pupils to respect the law & the basis on which it is made iv. Help pupils to understand that living under the rule of law protects individuals v. Welcome visits from the police vi. Develop restorative justice approaches to resolve conflicts
Individual Liberty	<p>Respect for the liberties of all within the law.</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Support pupils to develop their self-knowledge, self-esteem & self-confidence ii. Encourage pupils to take responsibility for their behaviour, as well as knowing their rights iii. Challenge stereotypes iv. Implement a strong anti-bullying culture v. Support the UNICEF rights respecting schools agenda
Mutual Respect & Tolerance	<p>Respect for & tolerance of different faiths & other beliefs.</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Promote respect for individual differences ii. Help pupils to acquire an understanding of, & respect for, their own & other cultures & ways of life iii. Challenge prejudicial or discriminatory behaviour iv. Discuss differences between people & differences of family situations, such as looked-after children or young carers
