Mrs Angela Nicholl – Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL)

Mrs Nicholl ensures that all policies and procedures are up to date and known by all who enter the school. The School Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) is the first point of contact for any member of the school staff who has a concern about the safety and wellbeing of a pupil.



Mrs Laura Whittington – Child Protection Coordinator (CPC)

Mrs Whittington ensures that all staff are kept up to date with training and changes to procedures. The CPC may also offer staff training in school or may organise specialist training where needed. Parents can approach Mrs Whittington if they have a child protection concern.



Mrs Joanne Thomas – Safeguarding Support (SS)

Mrs Thomas offers frontline parental support to help you engage with your child's learning and development. She can provide accessible information, explanation, and guidance on any worries or concerns parents may have about their children.
