

Annual reviews

Pupils with statements at Greenside primary have a review which is held once a year and are based upon pupil centred reviews. These involve the SENCO, class teacher, key workers, parents and carers, representatives from the Local Authority, other multi agency staff and of course, the pupil. These meetings are informative, inviting and helpful to all involved.

Parents are invited via letter to these reviews at least 2/3 weeks prior to the meeting.

- The SENCO will contact parents/carers to remind them of the review, and advise them to think about questions they may wish to ask and discuss any issues that may arise.
- All professionals working with the child will be invited to the annual review. If they cannot attend, it is anticipated that they will forward a report that can be shared at the meeting.
- Each child is invited to join the review and share their pupil voice that includes what they like/dislike about school, what they have learnt so far, what they have enjoyed learning, who helps them etc.
- Parents and carers are invited to contact school via the SENCO, at any time, if they need advice or support in regard to their child's education.
