



# Languages Assessment

## Listening

- To be able to identify the meanings of simple words and phrases they hear by matching to an object / picture / person etc.

## Speaking

- To be able to understand a few familiar spoken words and phrases and respond to simple questions e.g. What is your name? How are you? etc. and others depending on topics covered.
- To be able to say or repeat some familiar words and short simple phrases.

## Reading

- To be able to identify the meanings of simple words and phrases they see by matching to an object / picture / person etc.
- To be able to recognise and read out a few familiar words and phrases and are starting to notice the sound spelling patterns.

## Writing

- To be able to write or copy a few simple words or symbols accurately.
- To be able to be aware that symbols e.g. accents, umlauts exist and what they do ( also capital letters in German ).

## Grammar

- To be able to understand some basic aspects of language structure e.g. gender, definite and indefinite articles, singular and plural, nouns, adjectives.
