Upper Phase Y5 and Y6 Proud Competition Winners

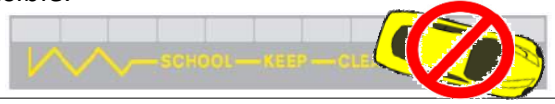

Please remember that if your child has moved to Y3 from Y2 they will no longer receive Universal Free School Meals unless you receive one of the following:

- Income Support.
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance.
- Income related Employment Support Allowance.
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999.
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit.
- Child Tax Credit - as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 and **do not** get Working Tax Credit.
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit).
- Universal Credit.
- Housing Benefit Council Tax Support
