Impact of SG in 2015/16			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 200 children accessed intensive swimming lessons of which 94 children can now swim 25+ meters • Top up swimming lessons were offered for older children who had not yet achieved the 25m award • Children took part in high quality PE lessons and the teaching of PE was judged to be outstanding. • All children in school accessed skating lessons resulting in 12 children being signposted to specialist ice sport training • Increased numbers of pupils took part in a growing number of inter school competitions (13 in total) and all children had access to intra school sport competitions (10 competitions in total) • Subject Leader has access to high quality CPD • The school worked in partnership with Nottingham Forest to offer high quality football lessons and after school club provision. Where appropriate children were signposted towards the Forest Academy – one child representing the club in a European competition. • The school was awarded the Sainsbury's School Games Gold Mark <p>Please note that the academy places such a high priority on providing the children with best opportunities to access sport and adopt a healthy lifestyle that we top up the grant from other school income</p>
