

The Chelmsford Cathedral School Foundation

The Trust was founded in 1997 after the sale of some property owned by the school; as a result of careful investment and generous donations, it has funds available to provide financial assistance for the benefit of pupils and staff. The Trust's aim is to advance the education of the children of The Cathedral School.

As a Voluntary Aided Church School our funding comes from several different sources. Funding for any building work comes from the Diocese but we have to contribute 10% towards the cost of it ourselves. In recent years the Trust has been able to make significant contribution to improve the fabric of the school buildings which have included:

- £78,000 towards the extensions of the classrooms
- £25,000 towards the Early Years' Unit
- £20,000 towards improving the school

The Trust has also helped to improve the IT facilities enjoyed

by the pupils and staff at the school by contributing £4,600 towards the costs of computers and interactive white boards. The Trustees are committed to providing continued financial assistance to the school and in order to do this invite parents to contribute to the Trust by one off payments or standing orders which enable the Trustees to invest further in improving the environment and opportunities of the pupils and staff.

If you pay tax at the basic rate (20%) then Gift Aid means that

for every pound you give, we receive an extra 25 pence from HM Revenue & Customs helping your donation go further.

That means that even a monthly donation of just £2 is worth more than £30 to the Trust over the course of the year.

A contribution of this size helps the Trust support the school and all the pupils. If you are able to gift aid your donation, please complete the declaration opposite and return it to the Gift Aid Secretary. You will also find a Bankers Order opposite which should be completed and sent directly to your Bank to facilitate payments.
