

Evaluation of SDP 2015-16

We have had another successful year:

- Outstanding assessment results in EYFS - GLD is 81% .National in 2016 was 69%
- Year 1 phonic screen results were high again with 83% meeting the standard.
(National Data 2016- 81%) From the Year 2 re-screens there was an increase from 87% to 87.5% meeting the standard.
- Key stage 1 results were outstanding during the first year of new testing arrangements. (National 2016 Reading: 74%, Writing: 65%, Maths: 73%) in reading 88% were at the expected standard or above (33%GD), In writing 86% at expected or above (25% GD) and in maths 87% at expected or above (25% GD)
- The key stage 1 outdoor classroom was updated, with phase 2 being completed.
- The ICT infrastructure was upgraded
- LA moderation of Key Stage 1 assessments— verified school judgements

Challenges to 2016—2017 include:

- Training for and managing specific medical / developmental needs of individual children
- Removal of levels and new Y2 testing—national benchmarks
- Changes to National Funding Formula
- Academy conversion - establishing the learning trust

However there will also be new opportunities:

- Academy conversion and strengthening partnerships
- Computing curriculum and improved infrastructure
- Phase 3 of the outdoor classrooms
- Our tracking system that is fit for purpose and meets the needs of the new Curriculum and our high expectations

This plan identifies the priorities that are key to whole school improvement and will form the basis for staff appraisals.
