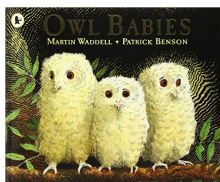


## What a great week!

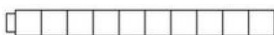
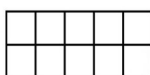
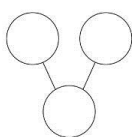
