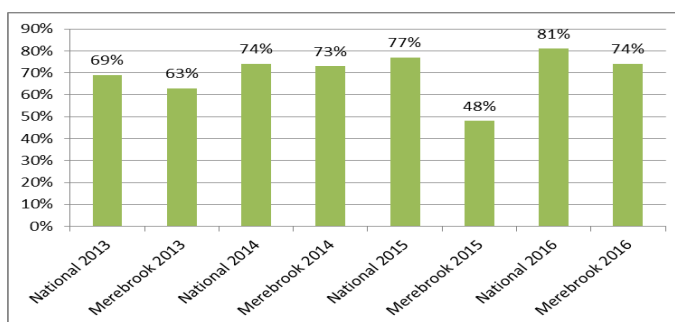

School Results 2016 (Phonics and KS1)

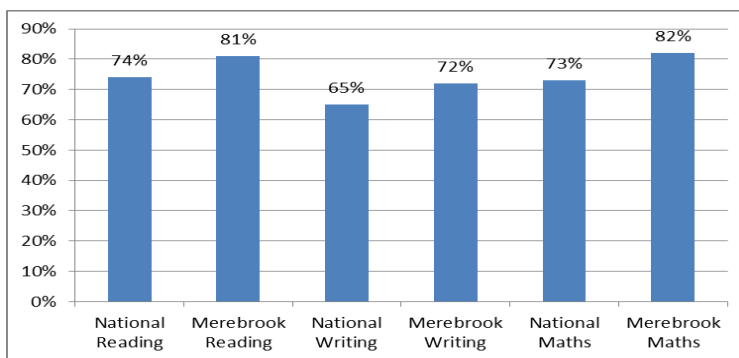
Phonics standard:

74% of children met the expected phonics standard in Year 1 in 2016, a 26% increase from 2015. See table below showing the School and National results from 2013 to 2016:



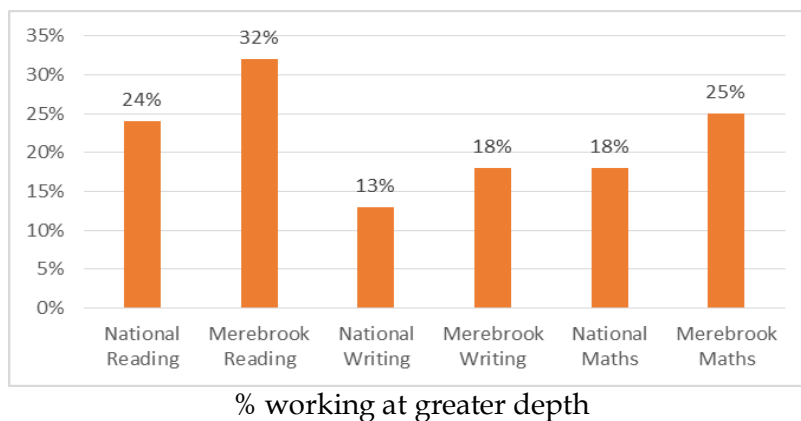
Key Stage 1:

Pupils were assessed against the new more challenging curriculum, which was introduced in 2014, for the first time this year. Results are no longer reported as levels, the interim frameworks for teacher assessment have been used by teachers to assess if a pupil has met the new, higher expected standard. Because of these assessment changes, figures for 2016 are not comparable to those for earlier years. The expectations for pupils at the end of key stage 1 have been raised. The graphs below show that the percentage of Merebrook children reaching the expected standard and working at greater depth within the expected standard is above National in all subjects:

The expected level of attainment at the end of Key Stage 1 (Year 2) is a National Curriculum level 2b. Children working at a level 3 are working at above expected levels of attainment and children working at a level 2c are working just below expected levels of attainment. Each National Curriculum level (2c, 2b, 2a, 3 etc.) has a points value. The school converts the children's levels into points and divides the total number of points by the number of children to get the Average Points Score (APS).
