### Reminder: Juniors visit to Saltaire

This half term the juniors will be doing a short topic about Victorians and the effect the rise of the manufacturing industry had on our locality. As part of this we will be visiting Saltaire by train on Friday 11<sup>th</sup> November for a tour of the village, a visit to t'mill and a ride on the Shipley Glen Tramway.

Children will be travelling by train. They will need dropping off at Skipton station at 8.45am ready to catch the 9am train and picking up from the railway station in Skipton at 4.09pm. If you have any problems doing this please let us know. Children will need to bring a packed lunch and may want to bring some spending money (no more than £5). They will be outside much of the day may need an extra layer under their school uniform together with a warm coat and comfortable shoes. If you have not already done so please fill in the consent slip attached and send with a contribution of £7.50 for the train fare (or pay via Parent Pay).

**Also we have a couple of children struggling to get to Skipton on Friday, if you are able to take any extra children to the station, picking them up from school, please let us know, it would be really appreciated.**

### Dinner and Sports Charges

For the half term 31st October to 16th December 2016

**Dinners:** Yr 3, 4, 5 & 6: £2.10 per day x 34 days = £71.40 (excludes 11th Nov)

Nursery children £1.60 per day + £1.50 care costs = £3.10 per day

**Swimming:** Yr 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 £4 per week x 7 weeks = £28.00

**Sport:** Year 3, 4, 5 & 6 £1 per week x 7 weeks = £7.00 less £3 deduction for the weeks sport was held at school instead of the village hall last half term. **Therefore sport payable = £4.** This is charge towards transport costs payable in advance. An adjustment is made to the following half terms fee when any reduction due because PE is held at school rather than the Village Hall will be taken in to account.

Adjustments: If you have any credits or debits for dinners from last term then please add or deduct from the dinner amount payable. Likewise if you have any debits or credits from swimming/sport then please deduct from the swimming/sport amount.
