# INFORMATION



- **Remembrance Day** (sometimes known as **Poppy Day**) is a memorial day observed in [Commonwealth of Nations](#) member states since the end of the [First World War](#) to remember the members of their armed forces who have died in the line of duty. Following a tradition inaugurated by King [George V](#) in 1919,<sup>[1]</sup> the day is also marked by war remembrances in many non-Commonwealth countries. Remembrance Day is observed on 11 November in most countries to recall the end of hostilities of World War I on that date in 1918. Hostilities formally ended "at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month", in accordance with [the armistice](#) signed by representatives of Germany and the Entente between 5:12 and 5:20 that morning. ("At the 11th hour" refers to the *passing* of the 11th hour, or 11:00 am.) The First World War officially ended with the signing of the [Treaty of Versailles](#) on 28 June 1919.
