



## St Anne's Community Special School

### Year 7 Catch-up Premium 2013-2014

#### 1. PURPOSE

The Year 7 literacy and numeracy catch-up premium grant 2013-2014 will be paid pursuant to Section 14 of the Education Act 2002, and in accordance with Section 16 of that Act the Secretary of State lays down the following terms and conditions on which assistance is given in relation to this grant payable to the Authority for the financial year beginning 1 April 2013.

The Year 7 catch-up premium per pupil for 2013-2014 is as follows:

The Year catch-up premium for 2013-14 will include all Year 7 pupils who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or mathematics at Key Stage 2 based on the 2013 Key Stage 2 data. These data have been matched with the autumn 2013 school census data to work out allocations for each local authority and school. For pupils in Alternative Provision lagged data will be used.

A maximum of £500 for each pupil who has not achieved at least level 4 in reading and/or maths has been allocated. The grant has been allocated as set out in sections A, B and C below

St Anne's was awarded £2,500-00 (5 pupils)

As part of the schools regular performance monitoring we monitor the impact of the premium. Achievement data will be checked frequently to assess whether interventions and techniques are working and adjust them accordingly.
