## Year 7 Catch-up Premium 2014-2015

## 1. PURPOSE

The allocation is £500 for each pupil in a state-funded school who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or mathematics at key stage 2. The final figures have been calculated using the 2014 key stage 2 data and the autumn 2014 school census data.

The funding was announced by Schools Minister David Laws on 11 November 2014 St Anne's was awarded £2,500-00 (5 pupils)

As part of the schools regular performance monitoring we monitor the impact of the premium. Achievement data will be checked frequently to assess whether interventions and techniques are working and adjust them accordingly.
