### The Pupil Premium Grant for Sutton Benger CE (VA) Primary School – 2015 update

In April 2011 the Government introduced the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG); an allocation of money given directly to schools based on their children and their family situations. Children are entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) if they are eligible for free school meals (or have been at any time in the last 6 years), Looked After Children and children from families where at least one parent is in the Armed Forces.

The information below shows how this money has been spent and the impact on our pupils during 2015 – 2016 and how we intend to spend our allocation for 2016 – 2017.

Total amount of PPG received April 2015	£19064.25

How this allocation was spent
Intervention teacher (1 day per week) to work with small groups of children.
Teaching Assistant intervention to support whole class, small group and individual work.
Additional teacher time (1/2 day) to support maths intervention groups
Resources including access to IT curriculum resource
Parent support advisor involvement.
Training courses (Team Teach, Back on Track, ELSA training)

### **What impact has this had on the children in our school?**

- The large majority of FSM children are working at age related expectations; those children who did not make the expected progress have additional needs.
- All Service family children (100%) are working at age related expectations.
- Additional training for staff has supported children in a range of areas, particularly encouraging confidence and approach to learning, ensuring that the children are making the best possible progress.

**For the year 2016 – 2017 we plan to use the Pupil Premium Grant as follows:**

How we plan to spend this allocation over the coming year
Additional Teaching Assistant time (An intervention TA to work with KS2 children who are not making expected progress).
Intervention teacher (1 day per week) to work with small groups of children.
Purchase of additional resources to develop movement skills and provide IT support programs
Parent support advisor involvement.
Additional SENCo time to track progress of these children and provide specific individual support where necessary.
