It is Mrs Robinson's special job to keep you safe-talk to her if you are worried.

Put something in the worry "eater" in your class – your teacher will check this regularly

Tell a friend and then go with your friend to tell an adult.

Someone is bullying you.



Someone is saying funny things to or about you that you do not like or upset you.



Someone is touching you.



Someone is trying to give you tablets, cigarettes, drugs or alcohol.



Someone is hitting you or hurting you.



Someone is sending unkind messages on the internet or to your phone.
