- ❖ Help you discover strategies for developing mathematical enquiry and challenge.

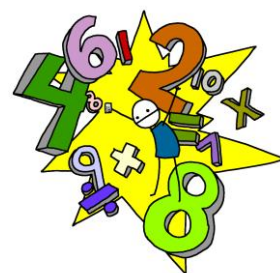

The Pilgrim Progress

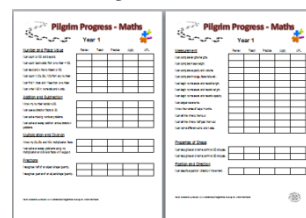
(including material and 2 twilight sessions to support implementation)
