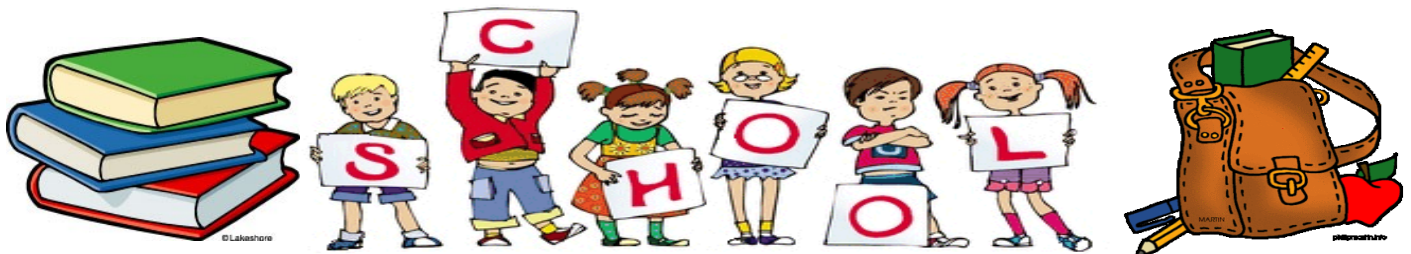
## Welcome to a new year at All Saints' Federation
