COURSE CONTENT:

The Reciprocal Reading techniques course provides time for teachers and leaders in school to come out of their school environment and immerse themselves in a focused session of training and interaction with colleagues. The content will focus upon using Reciprocal Reading to develop a more focused approach to supporting pupils to engage with text and gain deeper meaning and understanding from what is being read. This will in turn positively impact on pupil outcomes in reading.
