



Mowden Federation – Academic Results 2016

These are our Key Stage 2 Results (Year 6) from 2016. Parents should note that the national assessment system no longer uses levels. Children are expected to now reach the 'Expected Standard' in each subject and accompanying this is a 'Scaled Score' (a statistical standardised score calculated from the test marks) which ranges from 80 to 120.

Average progress scores¹:

Reading: -0.6
Writing: -2.2
Maths: -0.4

Average scaled scores:

Reading: 105.4 *
Maths: 105.7 *

Percentage of pupils who reached the Expected Standard or above:

Reading: 78% *
Writing: 75%
Maths: 84% *

Percentage of pupils who reached a high level of attainment²:

Reading: 35% *
Writing: 21%
Maths: 29% *

* denotes 'significantly above' the national average
