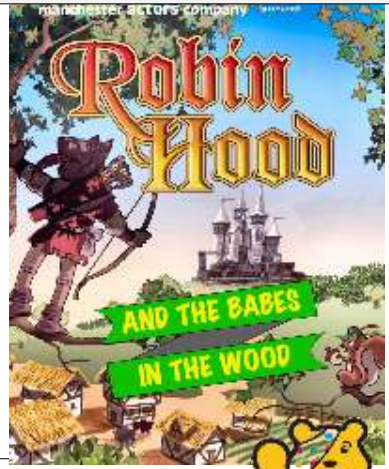
All baubles will be on display in Belle Vale Shopping Centre. Raffle prizes can be collected from the school office.

Parent Governor Elections

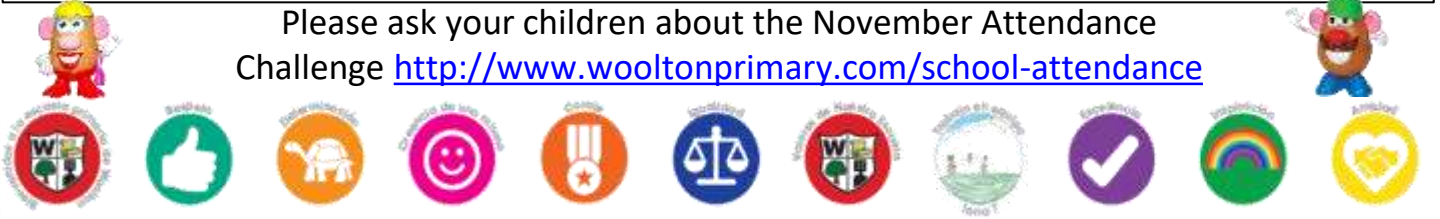
