Request for children to bring a mobile phone into school

Dear parent/carer,

As advised in our Acceptable Use policy, children are not to bring mobile phones into school without the express permission of their class teacher. Please complete the form below if you wish for your child to bring their mobile phone into school.

Permission will only be granted to Year Five and Year Six pupils for valid reasons, for example, you are allowing your children to walk to and from school by themselves and have their phone for emergency contact. Mobile phones should be switched off and will then be stored in the classroom teacher's cupboard during the school day in a designated box. The class teacher nor Wheatfield Primary School can be held accountable for any damage to or loss of this equipment.
