

Pupil Premium Grant Information

Assessment of Need

Pupils who are eligible for Pupil Premium on entry to the school will be assessed on the following basis:

- attainment and expected progress in English and Maths;
- attitude to learning;
- attendance;
- social and emotional development and behaviour;
- home life, health and welfare; and
- hobbies and interests.

Possible Areas of Support

All students eligible for Pupil Premium and who are making less than expected progress for any reason are entitled, if required, to:

- an analysis of their needs by the class teacher and Headteacher/SENCo
- a planned programme of intervention proven to be effective in addressing the identified learning need(s) including access to one to one and small group tuition in literacy and numeracy where necessary;
- access to specialist support where necessary;
- advice to parents about best methods for supporting student's specific needs
- a planned programme of behavioural, social and emotional support, with access to specialist help if needed;
- regular contact with parents, including work with multi-agencies;
- financial support for purchase of the basic school uniform;
- financial support for engagement in after school clubs and activities including transport; and
- financial support for residential visits.
