Summary of PPG Spending

Spending in the academic year 2014/15 was targeted towards the continued development of 3 intervention programmes for PPG children, in developing suitable workspaces for these children and providing additional in-class support to ensure that children attracting PPG are guaranteed additional challenge, attention and appropriate differentiation in the classroom, as well as having access to suitable resources.

We were also able to support all families by subsidising the school trips in Class 1 and Class 2, and the residential visit in Class 3 so that no families were treated differently as a result of inability to pay. This year, we have also been able to help 2 children access instrumental music lessons.

Impact

Over the past school year, those children receiving support funded by the PPG made the following points progress compared to their peers.
