



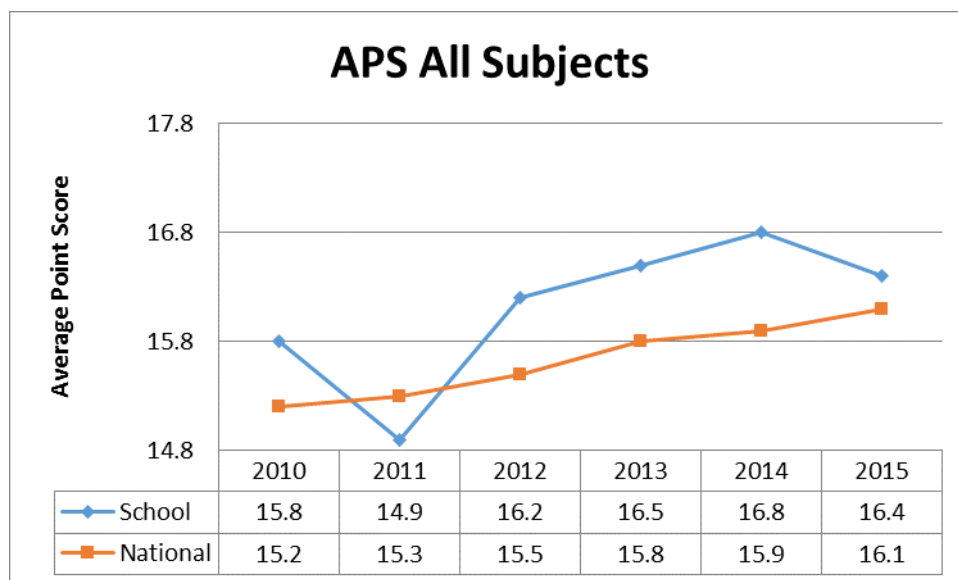
Key Stage One Results Summer 2015

At the end of Year Two, pupils are expected to achieve a Level 2b or higher. Pupils achieving Level 3 are exceeding national expectations.

The school has maintained high levels of attainment, with pupil attainment in line with, or exceeding national figures this year. The proportion of pupils achieving a level 2b+ in writing was significantly above national figures:

Average point scores are used to give an average score for all pupils based on the level they achieve in Reading, Writing and Mathematics:



Average point scores for a child in our school is **above national figures**. Although there was a dip in 2011, there is an upward trend over the five year period and high standards of attainment are maintained.
