

## Muirburn Code Review Workshop

As part of the review of the Muirburn Code, three workshops have been organised.

The aim of these workshops is to gather views from people with experience of burning, cutting and grazing management to help us to develop the revised Code, so that it is relevant to people who work in different parts of Scotland.

The revised Code will recognise the value and importance of muirburn, and it will describe some new techniques and introduce some new features, so that muirburn continues to meet the requirements for effective management of moorland.

### Workshops:

- Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> February – Carfraemill, Lauder.
- Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> February – Sabhal Mor Ostaig, Isle of Skye.
- Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> February – Edinglassie, Huntly.

The programme for the day will start at 10.30am and finish by 3.00pm. In the morning, there will be discussion about the Code to explain why it is being reviewed and how the revised version will be different. After lunch there will be a visit to a nearby moorland to further discuss the issues raised.

A final, indoor workshop will take place at SNH, Battleby on Tuesday 14th March to pool the range of views and develop the final version of the Code.
