# Expectations in class

- Arriving in lesson and getting started
- Listening to instructions, focussing
- Making an effort to do what is asked
- Completing set work in the time given
- Taking care in accuracy and presentation
- Desire to learn and improve

# Spellings

- Taken from statutory year 6 spellings list – result in an accumulated bank of words
- Practise writing spellings/ look – cover – write – check method / write within a sentence to use words
- Importance of building wider vocabulary knowledge
- Application within written work
- Secondary schools add marks for GAPS(Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling)
- Life skill to be able to spell!

# Reading

- Expectation that pupils still read daily
- Library and/or Bug Club
- Use Reading Record for any reading – title then page numbers/ chapters and date – continue with date and pages until finished book
- Bring in on Thurs with completed spelling book

# Wizard Writes

- Talk slip home on Thursdays (fortnightly)
- Pupils will have completed several sessions of preparatory work in preparation for Wizard Write
- Encourage pupil to talk through their ideas
- Prepare key words/ ideas on paper or back of talk slip
- All writing is viewed by moderators for SATs level including IPC books and Wizard Writes

# Maths

- Times tables – importance to see number links
- My Maths – replacing Mathletics as Home Learning – tasks set weekly, can keep repeating task till achieve 100%
- Applied Maths at home... measuring, weighing, counting, cooking, capacity, sharing, dividing, telling the time, reading timetables, looking at calendars, money, shopping – eg. comparing prices and offers, sale reductions
- CGP Maths Workbooks – pages set weekly



# Workbooks

- Each pupil has a level 3-5 CGP Maths workbook (Mrs Emecz's also have level 6 books)
- Use as consolidation work/ revision of work completed recently in class
- Teacher will set 2 – 3 pages per week
- Out on Mon, back within week when completed
- If pupil can't do it due to lack of understanding, then teacher will give enhancement that week
- If not completed for other reasons, pupil will complete during their break times at school – books must be in school on Mondays
- Pupils will self mark at school
