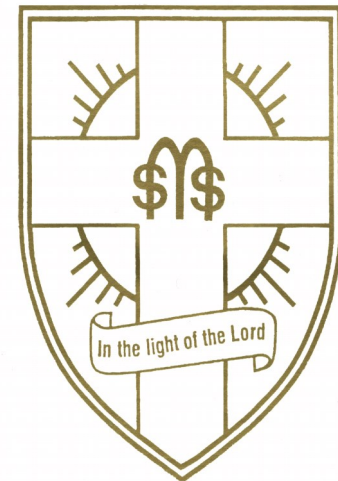

Agreement for Parents/Carers.

To help my/our child at school and to acknowledge that parents are the first educators of children, I/we will do my/our best to:
