### Pupil Premium- Proposed use of allocated funds

Contribution towards cost of employment of teacher to facilitate two KS2 classes in the mornings

Employment of a speech therapist

Contribution towards cost of employing teaching assistants to support learning within the classroom and through targeted intervention as appropriate

Purchase of resources to support specific children

THRIVE programme

Continued professional development to support effective use of pupil premium funding e.g training for teachers and teaching assistants in developing and improving feedback prompts to pupils

Funding for extracurricular activities e.g. residential trips

### Impact of Pupil Premium Funding

Two children in Year 6 qualified for the pupil premium grant. One of these pupils joined the school in the latter half of Year 5. One of these pupils received SEN support.

50% achieved the national standard in reading  
 0% achieved the national standard in Writing  
 0% achieved the national standard in Mathematics  
 50% achieved the national standard in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

100% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium have made the expected progress in Reading  
 0% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium have made the expected progress in Writing  
 0% of pupils eligible for Pupil Premium have made the expected progress in Mathematics

One pupil in Year 2 qualified for pupil premium.  
 100% attained the expected standard in Reading  
 100% attained the expected standard in Writing  
 100% attained the expected standard in Mathematics

Of the remaining 5 children who qualified for PP funding across the school, all were in KS2, one has a statement of educational need and is assessed on P Levels and one pupil arrived in the latter half of the year. of the pupils for whom progress on the national curriculum can be tracked;

20% are at national expectations or above in reading  
0% are at national expectations or above in writing  
0% are at national expectations or above in mathematics

33% made good or better progress in writing
