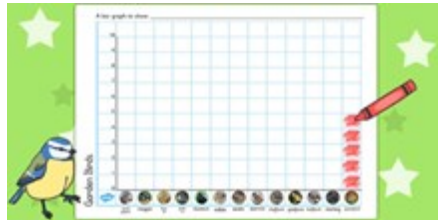


Year 1 Home Learning - Spring 1 2017

Maths

Take part in the R.S.P.B Big Garden Bird-watch on the 28-30th January. Spend time looking at the different types of birds that visit your garden and record your findings in any way you like.



Geography

Discuss together journeys that you have made in your family. It may be journeys around Hertfordshire, England, Europe or the world. Please talk about what transport you used for the different journeys and why. You may wish to record by drawing and labelling or sticking pictures. The choice is yours.

Maths – Time

To help your child understand how long 1 minute is could you have some races to see how many things you can do in 1 minute? It could be: How many times can you hop, jump, write your name in 1 minute? How far can you count? How many toys can you put in a line? How many lego bricks can you stick together? in 1 minute?



Science/Geography/DT—where does food come from?

On your next visit to a supermarket with an adult, can you find any food that has been grown, made or packaged in a different country? You may draw, photograph, cut the label or find your own way to show what you have found out

Science – The Weather

Keep a weather diary for a week (or more if you wish) recording the weather.
