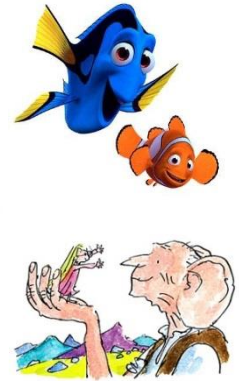


## Children's Film Nights
